## **Policy on Photography and Video Filming of Children March 2010**

Hertingfordbury Cricket Club adopts the ECB Guidelines on Photography and Video Camera Guidelines as set out in the attached ECB document. In particular:

Taking of photographs/ images:

- Photographs /Images are not to be taken at matches or training without the prior of the parents /carers of the children. This permission can be given by proxy by the coach of each team only after parental consent for this has been granted. The coach must arrange this prior to attending matches. A parental consent form is included in the 2009 player registration form.
- The children should be informed that a person will be taking photographs.
- The children should be informed that if they have concerns they can report these to their coach, the Team Manager or Club Welfare Officer
- Concerns regarding inappropriate or intrusive photography should be reported to the Club Welfare Officer and recorded in the same manner as any other child protection concern.
- For home cricket matches, tournaments, festivals, events or competitions organised by Hertingfordbury CC, a camera registration book will be set up for parents and spectators to complete.

Use of images of children, (for example on the club website, in the media or in league handbooks):

- We will ask for parental/carer and child's permission to use their child's image and wherever possible show the image to the parents/ carers and child in advance. This ensures that they are aware of the way the image will be used to represent Cricket and the Club
- If the cricketer is named, we will avoid using their photograph.
- If a photograph is used, we will avoid naming the child
- We will endeavour to only use images of children in appropriate kit (training or competition), to reduce the risk of inappropriate use, and to provide positive images of the children
- If you are concerned about the inappropriate use of images of children, please report your concerns to the County or Club Welfare Officer
